Mitomycin-C Kyowa all strengths - Supply Disruption Alert - Update

Summary

- All unexpired batches of Kyowa Kirin Mitomycin-C, as listed below, are subject to a MHRA Class 2 recall EL (19)A/33.
- Kyowa Kirin will be unable to support the UK market for at least 12 months.
- UKMi, in full consultation with clinical experts in the fields of Oncology and Ophthalmology, has drafted clinical advice to support local management of this supply disruption, should sufficient imports not be available to support full demand https://www.sps.nhs.uk/articles/shortage-of-mito...wa-all-strengths/

Action

All healthcare professionals in secondary or specialist healthcare services who prescribe, compound, dispense or administer mitomycin should:

- ensure orders are placed for unlicensed imports immediately;
- work with Regional Pharmacy Procurement Specialists to share available stock between Trusts to minimise impact on patients partway through a mitomycin containing regimen; and
- in discussion with local clinical specialists, consider ringfencing the stock available for priority indications and agreeing alternatives for others, as outlined in the clinical memo.

Problem / background

The above products have been recalled by Kyowa Kirin Ltd as a precautionary measure due to deviations from the aseptic manufacturing processes during the manufacture of the sterile active pharmaceutical ingredient and excipients.

NHS England & Improvement and the Department of Health and Social Care are working with alternative marketing authorisation holders Medac and Accord to make mitomycin products available to the UK market in the next two to six months, respectively, to mitigate the impact of this supply disruption.
